




SSM EYE RESEARCH FOUNDATION

SSM EYE RESEARCH FOUNDATION, a registered Charitable Trust was formed on 01.10.2005 **under Giridhar Eye Institute** for various community centric activities, such as (a) Free Cataract surgery with intra ocular lens implantation for persons below poverty line (BPL), (b) to provide medical relief to economically weaker section of society, School Screening programme, (c) a project for vision testing in primary school children, (d) Conduct Diabetic Retinopathy Awareness and Screening camps, (e) to provide a fully equipped Mobile Eye Unit to go to the villages & remote areas for a comprehensive eye examination, and (f) Establishing a center for rehabilitation of Visually handicapped.


The trust has been doing charitable activities since last 10 years specially concentrating on eye care. The trust conducts free eye camps in remote areas and villages, examine people, identify the eye problems and do surgical procedures either free or at concessional rates without any profit motive where necessary. The trust also conducts awareness sessions and issues patient education materials in connection with different eye related disease for creating awareness. All these activities are done in association with its parent unit 'Giridhar Eye Institute'.




The performance of the trust in its philanthropic activities is shown as under:

- The trust is running 3 free eye clinics in Ernakulam Districts viz. (a) Gurudwara (b) Rotary Balbhavan and (c) Chaithanya Nursing Home, North Parur.
- Free eye check-up camp in Gurudwara has been running since 7/8 years very effectively.
- Screening Camp in Rotary Balbhavan held since 3-4 years.
- Clinic at North Parur has been started in August 2014, while our association with Chaithanya Nursing Home has been there for a long time for Diabetic Retinopathy screening programs.
- Apart from the above, outreach programs are held at least three Sundays in a month in association with various NGO's. In all, on an average, 5-6 such programs are held a month.
- Launched an awareness program on a wide-scale to educate patients and general physicians on Diabetes and eye diseases, as treatment for diabetic retinopathy is still not within the reach of a poor man.

STATISTICS OF OUTREACH ACTIVITIES UNDERTAKEN IN 2015

⇒ World Glaucoma Day Screening Program held on 15th March 2015:

Optometry has conducted a one day awareness and exhibition program-NAYANA 2015 with the *support* of SSM eye research foundation. The program was conducted at Oberon mall, one of the busiest business centre in Kochi and witnessed continuous foot fall all the day. The exhibition has covered all the sub specialty of ophthalmic care and emphasized the relevancy of specialized treatment in different conditions.



⇒ COMPREHENSIVE EYE SCREENING



Giridhar Eye Institute organized a comprehensive eye screening for farmers, agriculture labours, shop owners of Poothotta and their employees in association with NCC unit of KPMHSS, Puthiyakavu, Poothotta on 11th October 2015. The NCC cadets reached the nook and corner of Poothotta and completed the pre-registration for the camp. Totally 246 people were screened through the program and out of them 82 were referred to the base hospital on different OP days.

Mr. Dani Thomas, DMRC Project Director inaugurated the screening in the presence of Mr. Kesav Chandran, Chief engineer, DMRC, Dr. Giridhar A, Medical Director Giridhar Eye Institute and Dr. Kanchana Giridhar, Assistant Medical Director Giridhar Eye Institute. 750 employees were screened and few of them were dispensed with free spectacles.
